


Fellowship Meals are Going Green

Job Opening: Children's Admin. Assistant



YOUTH GROUP

Clear Water Youth Group - Robert Regalado, reporter

At the Clear Water Church youth group, we do many activities with other teens. The leaders of this group are: Sandy Vasquez, Narda Butler, Tracie Berkland, Tim Allen, and Greg Balcao, Melody Sarian, and Kevin Zuck also help lead. We meet every Wednesday at either Sandy Vasquez's or Narda Butler's house. If you need a ride you can contact any of the leaders. They will do as much as possible to make it happen.

When we first arrive to youth group, the first thing we do is talk with each other and make jokes while eating delicious food. Then, we do fun activities that the leaders come up with. For example, last week, we played Telephone Pictionary, which is a game where you get pieces of paper and number them 1 to as many people there are in the game and put them in order. Then, write a random word or sentence that you come up with, and then pass it to the person to your left. That person to your left draws what they think you are saying as well as they can. The next person to the left says in a sentence what he/she thinks the person before him/her drew. That person hands it to the left and the process repeats over, and over again, until it gets back to you. Then, you compare your original word or sentence to what the papers show. That is only one of the many fun games we play.

After the main activities are over at about 7:45 or sometimes 8:00. One of the leaders asks a question about things that are happening these days that is common between all of us and the world. That might be good or bad. Next, we try answering the questions and discuss the answers. After we are done discussing, the leader reads a passage in the Bible. We then discuss what we think it means. The fun thing is there is often no right or wrong answer. However, every answer is partially, or sometimes entirely, correct. To conclude the discussion, the leader says what the Bible is saying in more common words, so we can understand better. To reinforce our learning, we do an exercise about the topic. After this, we have a little bit of time to talk with each other before everyone goes home.



Youth group is a fun place to learn and make friendships. We have a say in what topics we discuss and games we play. I hope more youth come check it out.
